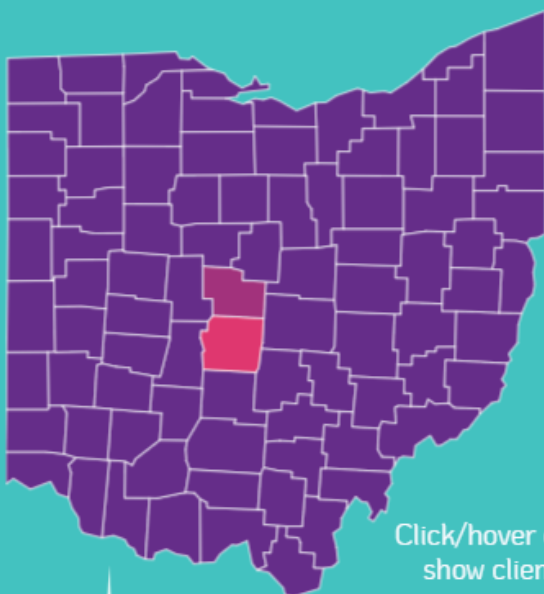

School-Based Prevention Program Spotlight

In December 2019, Syntero conducted a workshop for administrators from 12 Franklin, Delaware and Morrow County school districts to discuss best practices for Comprehensive Threat Assessment Teams, suicide awareness and prevention education



in the school setting. "We want to make sure there's a regional approach; that the districts are responding in similar ways and not feeling like they have to reinvent the wheel," said Syntero Chief Clinical Officer Sara Harrison-Mills, MSW, LISW-S. "There's a lot of good information and tools out there that schools can utilize for this process."

The workshop was a continuation of Syntero's Comprehensive Threat Assessment Summit that was held the previous year. Syntero provides ongoing direct services within 12 school districts and 2 specialty programs.
